Presentation Formats

Authors are required to indicate their preferred presentation format when submitting an abstract.

Workshops

A limited number of workshops places are available, and will run for 45mins each. Submissions will be assessed by the conference committee against how each will enhance the program in addition to the following criteria;

- Has a focused topic
- Provides insight and is likely to stimulate discussion
- Has clearly stated outcomes and is interactive and engaging with participants

Oral Presentations

Presenters will have a total of 25 minutes (20 minutes presentation and five minutes of discussion) in a concurrent session. It is recommended that Presenters use a maximum 15 slides and be prepared to answer 1- 3 questions at the conclusion of the talk.

Table Top Presentations

A new conference format, the table top presentations have replaced the more traditional poster sessions. In a room set with round tables of 10, the presenters will have 10 minutes to present to a table of delegates. At the end of a 10 minutes the presenter will move to the next table so at the end of the 90 minute session, each presenter will speak to 7 or 8 groups. Presenters should aim to talk for 6 to 7 minutes leaving time for questions from the table.

Poster submissions

Posters presentations should be A2 in size and be clear, precise and engaging. These will be hung on display boards in the conference hall.

Abstract Format

Abstracts should be submitted in the following format:

- The abstract should be a maximum of 200 words in simple text paragraphs without tables or subheadings
- The Title of the abstract should be no longer than 12 words.
- The abstract should commence with Title, followed by presenter/s name organisation and authors' names only.
- Abstracts submitted for presentation will be published exactly as received and should be checked for spelling and grammar prior to submission.
- If there is more than one presenter all correspondence will be sent to the person whose name and email is entered with the abstract.

All presenters must register at the time of confirming their acceptance of presentation and must pay the conference registration fee.
